

REACH and RoHS Statement

REACH Regulation

Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals

In January 2019, six more substances of very high concern were added to the REACH Candidate List of the European Union. This brings the total number of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) on the list to 197.

The REACH Regulation requires additional information if a product contains a substance included in the Candidate List in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight:

- Suppliers of a substance or a mixture shall provide the recipient of the substance or mixture with a safety data sheet.
- Suppliers of articles have to provide relevant safety information about the substance to the recipients of these articles. If no particular information is necessary to allow safe use of the article containing a substance from the Candidate List, as a minimum the name of the substance in question has to be communicated to the recipients.

The REACH Regulation defines an article as “an object which during production is given a special shape, surface or design which determines its function to a greater degree than its chemical composition”.

All PB Swiss Tools products are articles by this definition and do not require any safety data sheets.

Because all PB Swiss Tools products DO NOT contain a Candidate List substance according to our records and to the information we gathered from our suppliers, no additional action or information on our products is needed.

RoHS Directive

Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive

RoHS restricts the use of the following ten substances:

1. Lead (Pb)
2. Mercury (Hg)
3. Cadmium (Cd)
4. Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+)
5. Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
6. Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE)
7. Di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalat (DEHP)
8. Butylbenzylphthalat (BBP)
9. Dibutylphthalat (DBP)
10. Diisobutylphthalat (DIBP)

According to our records and to the information from our suppliers, all PB Swiss Tools products DO NOT contain any of these substances.

We confirm furthermore that our products are free of phthalates (e.g. DEHP, DBP, BBP , DIBP).

Based upon the above and the information currently available, all PB Swiss Tools products comply with the REACH regulation as well as with the RoHS directive.
